The Yarn

Giselle – 64% kid mohair, 25% wool, 11% nylon

Giselle is a beautiful kid mohair and wool blend. It's heavier than lace weight but still light and airy.

Kid mohair is fine and lustrous and has many of the good qualities of wool. It's soft and can absorb moisture yet still feel warm and dry. Giselle has great body- it is silky smooth to touch and wear, but not so drapery that a piece would lose its shape. When knit on a large needle, Giselle is lightweight and airy. The lustrous mohair also takes dyes beautifully as you can see in the dreamy colors of Giselle.

The Pattern

Skill Level: Easy

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS:

11" tall and 58¾" circumference blocked

YARN

Giselle by **Classic Elite Yarns**

(64% kid mohair, 25% wool, 11% nylon; 50 g = approx 230 yards)

1 ball each:

A – 4120 Darrow River

B – 4143 Olive Amber

C – 4156 Navarra

D – 4104 Myrtle

E – 4193 Porcelain Blue

NEEDLES

Circular knitting needle (32") in size US 9 (5.5 mm) **or size to obtain gauge.**

OTHER MATERIALS

Stitch marker

GAUGE: 15 sts and 23 rnds = 4" in 2 x 2 Rib, blocked. **Take time to save time, check your gauge.**





ABBREVIATIONS

approx: approximately
BO: bind off
BOR: beginning of round
CO: cast on
k: knit
p: purl
pc: piece
pm: place marker
rep: repeat
rnd(s): round(s)
st(s): stitch(es)

PATTERN STITCHES

Stripe Sequence:

4 rnds A, 2 rnds B, 4 rnds C, 2 rnds D, 4 rnds E, 2 rnds A, 4 rnds B, 2 rnds C, 4 rnds D, 2 rnds E.

2 x 2 Rib: (multiple of 4 sts)

All rnds: *K2, p2; rep from *.

COWL

With A, CO 220 sts. Pm for BOR and join to work in the rnd being careful not to twist. Work through Stripe Sequence twice while working in 2 x 2 Rib. With A, work 4 rnds in 2 x 2 Rib. BO all sts loosely in Rib.

FINISHING

Block pc to measurements.
