

Stripie Scarf

designed by Amy Loberg

Stripie is made up of two striped wedges. Knit the first one and then add the second, joining the two as you go. Finish with a short section of single crochet. Wear with any of your favorite outfits!

SKILL LEVEL

Intermediate

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Approx 10" deep x 68" long, blocked

YARN

Soft Linen by **Classic Elite Yarns**

(35% linen, 35% wool, 30% baby alpaca; 50 g = approx 137 yards)

2 balls each:

Color A – 2257 Kentucky Blue

Color B – 2250 Inca Gold

NEEDLES

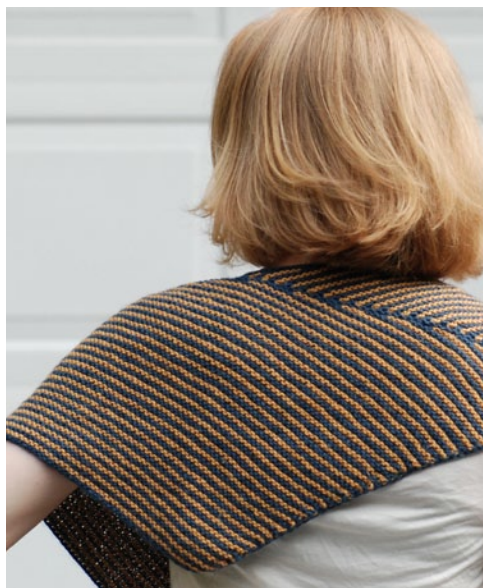
Circular knitting needle (24") in size US 5 (3.75 mm) **or size to obtain gauge.**

OTHER MATERIALS

Crochet hook in size US G/6 (4 mm)

GAUGE

21 sts and 42 rows = 4" in Garter Stitch. **Take time to save time, check your gauge.**

ABBREVIATIONS

approx: approximately
beg: begin(ning)
BO: bind off
CO: cast on
cont: continue
dec('d): decrease(d)
est: establish(ed)
g: gram(s)
inc('d): increase(d)
k: knit
k1-f/b: knit into the front and back of same st (1 st inc'd)
k2tog: knit 2 sts together (1 st dec'd)
LH: left hand
mm: millimeter(s)
pc: piece
rem: remaining
rep: repeat
RH: right hand
st(s): stitch(es)
WS: wrong side
yo: (yarn over) wrap the working yarn over the RH needle, from front to back (1 st inc'd)

PATTERN STITCHES

Garter Stitch (Gtr st):

Knit all sts, every row.

Cable Cast-on Method:

With sts on LH needle, *insert RH needle into the space between the last 2 sts. Wrap yarn as if to knit, pull st through and slip st to LH needle, rep from * for desired number of sts.

sc: (single crochet)

Insert crochet hook in indicated stitch, yarn over and pull up a loop; yarn over and draw through both loops on hook.

NOTES

- 1.) Circular needle is used to accommodate sts, scarf is worked back and forth in rows.
- 2.) Each ridge has 2 rows.
- 3.) When changing colors place the color just worked to the left of the new color so that the two yarns wrap in an even and uniform manner.

SCARF

With Color A, CO 182. (WS) Knit one row.

Shape Scarf with short rows and increases as follows:

Ridge 1: Join Color B, knit to last 3 sts, turn. Yo, knit to end.

Ridge 2: With Color A, knit to 4 sts before previous turn (3 sts + 1 yo = 4 sts), turn. Yo, knit to last 2 sts, k1-fb, k1 – 1 st inc'd.

Ridge 3: With Color B, knit to 4 sts before previous turn, turn. Yo, knit to end.

Ridge 4: With Color A, knit to 4 sts before previous turn, turn. Yo, knit to end.

Ridge 5: With Color B, knit to 4 sts before previous turn, turn. Yo, knit to last 2 sts, k1-fb, k1 – 1 st inc'd.

Ridge 6: With Color A, knit to 4 sts before previous turn, turn. Yo, knit to end.

Ridge 7: With Color B, knit to 4 sts before previous turn, turn. Yo, knit to end.

Rep Ridge rows 2-7 until all sts have been worked. The last row worked will be with Color B, k3, turn. Yo, knit to end.

Next row: With Color A, knit to end, knitting each yo together with the st that follows it – 204 sts.

Next row: BO 150 sts, knit to end – 54 sts.

Next row: K54 (center body), turn and use cable cast-on method to CO 156 sts – 210 sts.

Next row: With Color A, k156, k2tog (52 sts rem on LH needle) – 1 st dec'd. Turn and bring working yarn to back of work – 209 sts.

Note: While shaping pc with short rows a k2tog dec is worked twice in the section where the CO sts and center body sts meet.



Shape Scarf with short rows and decreases as follows:

Ridge 1: Join Color B and k2tog, pull Color A tight, k2, turn. Yo, k2, k2tog (1 CO st and 1 st from 52 center body sts), turn, move Color B to back of work – 2 sts dec'd.

Ridge 2: With Color A, k2tog, pull Color B tight, k1, knit yo together with next st, k2, turn. Yo, k4, k2tog, turn, move Color A to back of work – 2 sts dec'd.

Ridge 3: With Color B, k2tog, pull Color A tight, k3, knit yo together with next st, k2, turn. Yo, k6, k2tog, turn, move Color B to back of work – 2 sts dec'd.

Ridge 4: With Color A, k2tog, pull Color B tight, k5, knit yo together with next st, k2, turn. Yo, k8, k2tog, turn, move Color A to back of work – 2 sts dec'd.

Ridge 5: With Color B, k2tog, pull Color A tight, k7, knit yo together with next st, k2, turn. Yo, k10, k2tog, turn, move Color B to back of work – 2 sts dec'd.

Ridge 6: With Color A, k2tog, pull Color B tight, k9, knit yo together with next st, k2, turn. Yo, k12, k2tog, turn, move Color A to back of work – 2 sts dec'd.

Ridge 7: With Color B, k2tog, pull Color A tight, k11, knit yo together with next st, k2, turn. Yo, k14, k2tog, turn, move Color B to back of work – 2 sts dec'd.

Cont to shape pc and dec as est by k2tog at beg of first ridge row, then knitting to the yo (last st before gap) and knitting yo together with next st, then k2 before turning; on second ridge row, yo at beg of row, knit to last st before gap, then k2tog before turning. When 1 st rem on the center body and 3 CO sts rem at the end of scarf (107 sts) work as follows: With Color A, k2tog, knit to end of row, knitting yo together with next st. BO all sts, working k2tog at end of row as before, do NOT fasten off last st. With crochet hook and last st from BO, work 1 row of sc along short side of the first half to the bottom point. Fasten off.

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FINISHING

Weave in ends. Block pc to measurements.
