Add a luxury fiber blend of baby alpaca and bamboo to that inherent lightness and you have Chalet, a decadently soft yarn with a lovely drape in a chunky weight from our MountainTop Collection.

SKILL LEVEL

Easy

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

42" circumference x 14" tall, blocked

YARN

MountainTop Chalet by **Classic Elite**

(70% baby alpaca, 30% bamboo;

50 g = approx 98 yards)

1 hank each:

A – 7477 Charcoal

B – 7403 Steel

C – 7416 Parchment

D – 7443 Adobe

E – 7438 Chestnut

NEEDLES

Circular knitting needle (32") in size US 11 (8 mm) **or size to obtain gauge.**

GAUGE

13 sts and 20 rnds = 4" in Seed st, blocked. **Take time to save time, check your gauge.**

ABBREVIATIONS

approx: approximately

beg: begin(ning)

BO: bind off

CO: cast on

g: grams

k: knit

p: purl

rep: repeat

rnd(s): round(s)

st(s): stitch(es)

Classic Elite Yarns



COWL

With A, loosely CO 135 sts. Join to work in the rnd, being careful not to twist sts. *Note: placing a marker at beg of rnd is not necessary.*

Beg Seed St: *K1, p1; rep from * around until A is gone (approx 2.75").

Switch to next color and continue as established in Seed St until almost all of hank is gone. Continue in this manner until you've knit all 5 hanks, leaving enough of E (about 3x cowl circumference) to loosely BO all sts in pattern.

FINISHING

Weave in ends. If desired, lightly block cowl.

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
