SPROUT

Organic Cotton

Sprout is a cushy organic yarn with a slightly nubby texture. This yarn stays lofty, unlike many worsted-plus weight cotton yarns that tend to be heavy and dense once knit. Sprout is available in a bright-and-lively palette and it's machine washable. Add to this the wonderful soft texture, strength, and the light yet quick-to-knit gauge and it is easy to see why Sprout makes a great choice.



SKILL LEVEL

Intermediate

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

57" x 57"

YARN

Sprout by **Classic Elite, Verde Collection**

(100% organic cotton;

100 g = approx 109 yards)

13 hanks Color A – 4339 Cool Olive

5 hanks Color B – 4310 New Navy

NEEDLES

Knitting needles in size US 10 (6 mm)

or size to obtain gauge.

OTHER MATERIALS

Tapestry needle

GAUGE

Each square = 9½" x 9½", blocked.

Take time to save time, check your gauge.

Pillow patterns available separately in *Home Sweet Home 9143*, a collection of designs for the home from Classic Elite Yarns.

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ABBREVIATIONS

CO: cast on

dec('d): decrease(d)

EOR: every other row

inc('d): increase(d)

k: knit

k1-f/b: Knit into the front loop, then the back loop of next st (1 st inc'd).

k2tog: knit 2 sts together

m1: (make 1) Insert LH needle under horizontal strand between st just worked and next st, from front to back, knit through the back loop (1 st inc'd).

p: purl

p2tog: purl 2 sts together

rep: repeat

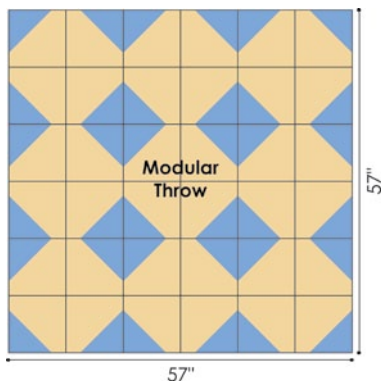
RS: right side

ssk: (slip, slip, knit) Slip 2 sts, 1 at a time, knitwise to RH needle; return sts to LH needle in turned position and knit them together through the back loops (1 st dec'd).

st(s): stitch(es)

WS: wrong side

yo: yarn over



SQUARE (MAKE 36)

With A, CO 2 sts, leaving a tail approx 12" long to use in sewing blocks together.

Next Row (RS): [K1-f/b] twice – 4 sts.

Purl 1 WS row.

Work Motif Chart for 30 rows – 34 sts.

Inc Row (RS): K2, m1, knit to last 2 sts, m1, k2 – 2 sts inc'd.

Rep inc row EOR twice more – 40 sts. Knit 1 WS row.

Dec Row: K1, ssk, k to end – 1 st dec'd.

Rep the dec row every row 5 more times – 34 sts.

Change to B.

Work dec row 4 more times – 30 sts.

****Next row (RS):** K1, ssk, * yo, k2tog; rep from * to last st, k1 – 1 st dec'd.

Next Row (WS): P1, p2tog, p to end – 1 st dec'd.

Work dec row every row 4 times – 24 sts.

Rep from ** once more – 18 sts. Work dec row every row 16 times – 2 sts.

Next Row: K2tog and fasten off leaving a tail approx 12" long to use in sewing blocks together.

FINISHING

Block squares to measurements.

With tapestry needle, use the tails from the CO and fastened end to sew squares together following diagram.
