ADELAIDE

Worsted weight pure merino in a palette of sumptuous heathers. This affordable merino is a go-to worsted weight you'll return to time and time again. The five neutral shades and seven classic colors are all subtly heathered, adding depth and nuance to your projects. The two plies and a firm z twist give it bounce and spring.

SIZES

S (M/L). Shown in size S.

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

17½ (20¼)" circumference

YARN

Adelaide by **Classic Elite Yarns**
(100% merino; 50 g = 123 yards)
MC – 1 (2) hank(s) 3603 Ash
CC – 1 hank 3647 Denim Blue

NEEDLES

Circular knitting needle (16") and double pointed needles (dpn) in size US 7 (4.5 mm) **or size to obtain gauge.**

Circular knitting needle (16") in size US 6 (4 mm)

OTHER MATERIALS

Stitch marker

GAUGE

22 sts and 26 rnds = 4" in Fair Isle patt.

Take time to save time, check your gauge.



Classic Elite Yarns

PATTERN STITCH

1 x 1 Twisted Rib (even number of sts)

All rnds: *P1, k1-tbl; rep from *.



ABBREVIATIONS

approx: approximately

CC: contrast color

CO: cast on

dec('d): decrease(d)

dpn: double pointed needles

inc('d): increase(d)

k: knit

k2tog: knit 2 sts together (1 st dec'd)

m1: (make 1) Insert LH needle under horizontal strand between st just worked and next st, from the front to the back, knit through the back loop (1 st inc'd)

MC: main color

p: purl

patt(s): pattern(s)

pc(s): piece(s)

rem: remain(ing)

rep: repeat

rnd(s): round(s)

st(s): stitch(es)

tbl: through back loop

HAT

With smaller circular needle, CO 90 (104) sts. Work in 1 x 1 Twisted Rib for 2".

Change to larger circular needle.

Inc rnd: [K15 (13), m1] 6 (8) times – 96 (112) sts.

Work Rnds 1-26 of Fair Isle chart once. Break CC.

Cont with MC only, knit 1 rnd.

Shape crown: Change to dpn when there are too few sts to fit comfortably around the circular needle.

Size M/L only:

Next rnd: *K12, k2tog; rep from * – 104 sts.

Knit 1 rnd even.

Next rnd: *K11, k2tog; rep from * – 96 sts.

Knit 1 rnd even.

All sizes:

Next rnd: *K10, k2tog; rep from * – 88 sts.

Knit 1 rnd even.

Next rnd: *K9, k2tog; rep from * – 80 sts.

Knit 1 rnd even.

Next rnd: *K8, k2tog; rep from * – 72 sts.

Knit 1 rnd even.

Next rnd: *K7, k2tog; rep from * – 64 sts.

Knit 1 rnd even.

Next rnd: *K6, k2tog; rep from * – 56 sts.

Next rnd: *K5, k2tog; rep from * – 48 sts.

Next rnd: *K4, k2tog; rep from * – 40 sts.

Next rnd: *K3, k2tog; rep from * – 32 sts.

Next rnd: *K2, k2tog; rep from * – 24 sts.

Next rnd: *K1, k2tog; rep from * – 16 sts.

Next rnd: *K2tog; rep from * – 8 sts rem.

FINISHING

Break yarn leaving an 8" tail. Thread tail onto tapestry needle and pull through all sts twice to close top of hat. Weave in ends.

Wash pc according to label instructions and block to measurements.

Optional: With CC, make a 2" pom pom. Sew pom pom securely to top of hat.
