designed by Susan Mills

CENTURY

Superbly soft baby alpaca in an extra bulky railroad construction makes Century a luxury yarn with instant gratification. No need for fancy stitches and detailed designs, simple shapes let this yarn shine.

SKILL LEVEL

Easy

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

20" circumference and 9" tall

YARN

Century by **Classic Elite Yarns**

(75% baby alpaca, 25% nylon;

100 g = approximately 98 yards)

1 hank 4425 Rose or 4446 Faded Teal

NEEDLES

Circular knitting needle (16") in size US 15 (10 mm) **or size to obtain gauge.**

OTHER MATERIALS

Stitch marker

GAUGE

10 sts and 13 rnds = 4" in St st. **Take time to save time, check your gauge.** *Exact gauge is not crucial for the success of this project, but if your gauge differs you may require additional yarn.*

ABBREVIATIONS

BO: bind off

CO: cast on

k: knit

LH: left hand

pc(s): piece(s)

pm: place marker

rep: repeat

RH: right hand

rnd(s): round(s)

st(s): stitch(es)

Classic Elite Yarns



PATTERN STITCHES

Stockinette Stitch (St st) in rnds: Knit all sts, every rnd.

Cable Cast-on Method: If there are no sts on the LH needle yet, place a slipknot on LH needle. Work k1 into first st or slipknot, slip new st onto LH needle; *insert RH needle between first 2 sts on LH needle, k1 from this position, leave the first st on LH needle and slip new st onto LH needle. Rep from * for desired number of sts.

COWL

Use the cable cast-on method to CO 50 sts.

Pm and join for working in the rnd, being careful not to twist sts.

Work in St st until pc measures 9" from CO.

BO all sts loosely.

FINISHING

Weave in ends. Block to measurements.
