

Classic Elite Yarns

Aspen Hat and Neck Tie

SIZES: One Size

Finished Measurements:

Hat—18" circumference;

Tie—31¼" length

MATERIALS:

Aspen by **Classic Elite** (50% alpaca, 50% wool; 100 gram hank = approx 51 yards)

- 2 hanks 1503 Mogul

Needles

- One pair US size 17 (12.75 mm)

Or size to obtain gauge

- Stitch markers

GAUGE: 8 sts and 10 rows = 4" in Stockinette Stitch (St st). **Take time to save time, check your gauge**

SPECIAL TERMS:

k2tog: Knit 2 sts together (1 st decreased).

k1-f/b: Knit into the front loop, then the back loop of next st (1 st increased).

ssk: (slip, slip, knit) Slip 2 sts, 1 at a time, knitwise to the RH needle; return sts to LH needle in turned position and knit them together through the back loops (1 st decreased).

p2tog: Purl 2 sts together (1 st decreased).

PATTERN STITCHES:

Seed Stitch: (multiple of 2 sts)

Row 1: (RS) *K1, p1; rep from * to end.

Row 2: Knit the purl sts and purl the knit sts.

Rep Row 2 for Seed St.

Stockinette Stitch (St st): Knit on RS, purl on WS.

NOTES:

1. Work inc sts on Neck Tie as follows: (RS) K1, k1-f/b, work to last st, k1-f/b, k1.

2. Work dec sts on Neck Tie as follows: (RS) Ssk, work across to last 2 sts, k2tog.

HAT

CO 36 sts. **(RS) Begin Seed St;** work 6 rows even, end WS row. **Change to St st;** work 2 rows even, end WS row. **Shape Crown:** K1, *place marker (pm), k2tog, k7, rep from * 3 times, end k2tog, k6—32 sts rem. Work 1 row even. **Dec Row:** *Work to marker, slip marker, k2tog; rep from * across, work to end—4 sts dec'd. Work Dec Row EOR 4 more times—12 sts rem. Break yarn leaving 15" tail.

FINISHING

Thread tail through rem sts. Block piece to measurements. Pull tail tight. Sew side seam.



NECK TIE

CO 1 st. **Shape Leaf 1, inc:** (RS) K1-f/b—2 sts.

(WS) Begin St st; work 1 row even. Next Row:

(RS) [K1-f/b] 2 times—4 sts. Work 1 row even.

(RS) Beg this row, inc 1 st each side EOR 2

times—8 sts. Work even for 2 rows, end WS

row. **Shape Leaf 1, dec:** (RS) Beg this row,

dec 1 st each side EOR 2 times—4 sts rem.

Change to Seed St; work even for 20", end RS

row. **Change to St st;** work 1 row even. **Shape**

Leaf 2, inc: (RS) Beg this row, inc 1 st each

side EOR 2 times—8 sts. Work even for 2 rows,

end WS row. **Shape Leaf 2, dec:** (RS) Beg this

row, dec 1 st each side EOR 3 times—2 sts

rem, end on last dec row. Next Row: (WS)

P2tog—1 st rem. Fasten off.

FINISHING:

Block piece to measurements.
