

# Classic Elite Yarns

## Bangles Crocheted Shawl

**SIZE:** One Size

**Finished Measurements:** 31" wide x 67" long

**MATERIALS:**

**Bangles** by **Classic Elite** (38% viscose, 36% tactel nylon, 26% nylon; 50 gram balls = approx 83 yards)

- 9 balls 6795 Amethyst

**Crochet Hook**

- One size US J/10 (6 mm)

**Or size to obtain gauge**

**GAUGE:** 6 [dc, ch 2] = 4" in Stitch pattern.

**Take time to save time, check your gauge.**

**PATTERN STITCHES:**

**Chain (ch):** Begin by making a slip knot on your hook. Wrap yarn around the hook (yarn over) and draw it through the loop on the hook to form the first chain. Rep this step as many times as instructed. (The first loop on the hook is never included when counting the number of chains).

**Single Crochet (sc):** Insert hook in indicated stitch, yarn over and pull up a loop; yarn over and draw through both loops on hook.

**Double Crochet (dc):** Yarn over hook, insert hook into indicated stitch, yarn over and pull up a loop; (yarn over and draw through two loops on hook) twice.

**SHAWL**

Row 1: Ch 5, dc in fifth ch from hook (counts as dc, ch 2), turn.

Row 2: Ch 5 (counts as first dc, ch 2), [dc, ch 2] twice in ch-2 space of previous row, dc in third ch of beg-ch, turn.

Row 3: Ch 5, [dc, ch 2] twice in first ch-2 space, \*[dc, ch 2] in next ch-2 space; rep from \* across to turning-ch, [dc, ch 2] twice in turning-ch space, dc in third ch of turning-ch, turn.

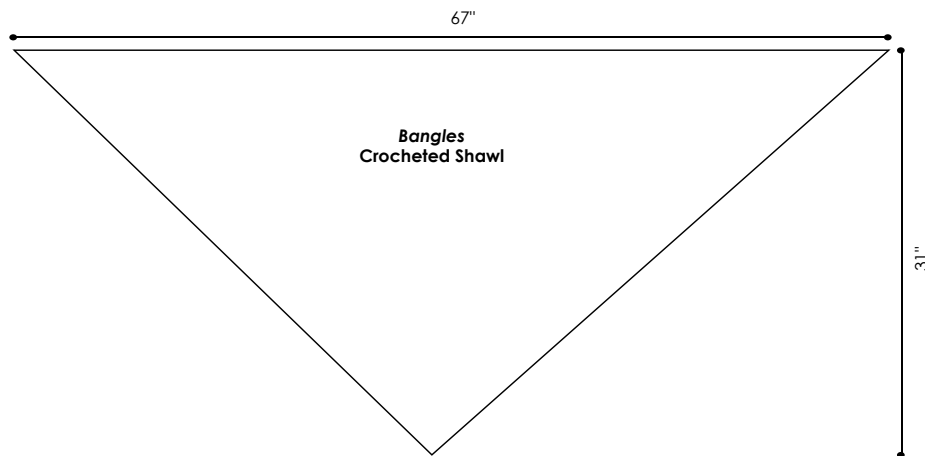
Row 4: Ch 5, \*dc, ch 2 in ch-2 space of previous row; rep from \* across to turning-ch, dc in third ch of turning-ch, turn

Rep Rows 3 and 4–19 times more. Rep Row 4–8 times more, turn (89 [dc, ch-1] spaces).

**PICOT EDGE**

Rnd 1: Ch 1, sc in top of first dc of previous row, \*ch 3, slip st in same sc, ch 2, sc in next ch-2 space; rep from \* across to turning-ch; sc in third ch of turning-ch, \*\*ch 3, slip st in same sc, ch 2, sc in next dc space along side edge; rep from \*\* along edge to beg-ch (point); sc in first ch of beg-ch, \*\*\*ch 3, slip st in same sc, ch 2, sc in next dc space along side edge; rep from \*\*\* along side to upper edge (beg of rnd), slip st in ch-1 of first picot. Fasten off. Block piece to measurements.
