Classic One Fifty Frothy Crochet Set

Classic One Fifty 100% fine merino

Classic one fifty is a smooth, soft, 100% merino yarn. Its lovely hand has to do with the softness of the fiber and the structure of the yarn. It's made from fine, fine plies which are themselves, fine, fine, fine plies twisted together. All the plies and the twisting create a round, tube-like lightweight yarn with very little fuzz on the surface. It's a great yarn not only for knitted projects, but for crochet ones, too.

Classic one fifty comes in a palette of 31 colors that offers many options for great color combinations. It knits up between 5½ and 6 stitches to the inch.

SIZES: Scarf: One size.
Mitts: Women's Small (Large)

Finished Measurements:
Scarf: 5½" wide; 60" long
Mitts: 8 (10)" hand circumference; 8½" long

MATERIALS:

Classic One Fifty by Classic Elite (100% extra fine merino; 50 gram ball = approx 150 yards)

- 3 balls Main Color (MC) 7720 Blue Sky
- 2 balls Contrast Color (CC) 7295 Gumdrop

Crochet Hook

Scarf:

- One size US F/5 (3.75 mm)

Mitts:

- One size US E/4 (3.5 mm)

GAUGE: 2 Shell Pattern reps = 3½", 6 rows = 3¾" in Scarf Shell Pattern with larger hook; 1 Shell Pattern rep = 2", 6 rows = 3½" in Mitt Shell Pattern with smaller hook. **Take time to save time, check your gauge.**

CROCHET STITCHES:

ch: (chain) Wrap the yarn around the crochet hook (yarn over) and draw it through the loop on the hook to form the first chain. Rep this step as many times as instructed. (The loop on the hook is never included when counting the number of chains).

dc: (double crochet) Yarn over hook, insert hook into indicated st, yarn over and pull up a loop; [yarn over and draw through 2 loops on hook] 2 times.

slip st: (sl st) Insert crochet hook in the indi-

cated stitch, yarn over and draw through both the stitch and the loop on the hook.

sc: (single crochet) Insert crochet hook in indicated stitch, yarn over and pull up a loop; yarn over and draw through both loops on hook.

tr: (treble crochet): Yarn over hook 2 times, insert hook in indicated stitch, yarn over and pull up a loop; (yarn over and draw through 2 loops) 3 times.

dc2tog: (double crochet 2 together) [Yarn over hook, insert crochet hook into next st, yarn over and pull up a loop] 2 times, yarn over and draw through all 3 loops on hook.

PATTERN STITCHES:

Shell: Work [3 dc, ch 1, 3 dc] into indicated st.

Half-shell: Work 3 dc into indicated st.

SCARF

With larger hook and MC, ch 26. See Scarf Shell Patt Chart and cont as follows:

Set-Up Row: Work half-shell in fourth ch from hook, *ch 2, sk 6 ch, work shell into next ch; rep from * to last 8 ch, ch 2, sk 6 ch, work half-shell in next ch, dc in last ch, turn.

Row 1: Ch 3 (counts as dc here and throughout), sk first dc, work half shell in next dc, ch 2, *work shell into ch-1 sp at top of shell, ch 2; rep from * to last half-shell, work half-shell into last dc, dc in third ch of tch, turn.

Row 2: Ch 3, sk first dc, work half-shell in next dc, ch 1, sk 2 dc, sl st into ch-2 sp 2 rows below (enclosing ch-2 sp of row below), ch 1, *work shell into ch-1 sp at top of shell, ch 1, sk 3 dc, sl st into ch-2 sp 2 rows below (enclosing ch-2 sp of row below), ch 1; rep from * to last half-shell, sk 2 dc, work half-shell in next dc, dc in third ch of tch, turn.

Row 3: Rep Row 1.

Rep Rows 1-3 until pc meas approx 60" long, end after Row 2

Final Row: Ch 1, sc in first dc, ch 6, *sc in ch-1 sp at top of next shell, ch 6; rep across. sc in third ch of tch. Fasten off.

PICOT EDGING

Join CC with sl st, to scarf at fasten off.

Rnd 1: With larger hook, beg working across Final Row, then along side edge, across foundation ch edge, then along second side edge as follows: Work 3 sc, ch 3, sl st from back to front into the previous sc; rep from * around. Join with sl st into first sc. Fasten off.
