# Classic Elite Yarns

### The Yarn

#### Firefly

75% Viscose, 25% Linen

Firefly is a warm-weather yarn with a subtle sheen and wonderful hand. The juxtaposition of the linen with a light-catching sheen gives it a distinctly feminine look. Firefly drapes wonderfully at a wide range of gauges - knit loosely for elegant lace or more tightly for stockinette fabrics.

### The Pattern

**Skill Level:** Intermediate

**FINISHED MEASUREMENTS:** 8½" wide and 65" long, after blocking

#### YARN:

**Firefly** by **Classic Elite** (75% viscose, 25% linen; 50 gram ball = approx 155 yards)

3 balls 7777 Britannia

**NOTE:** To make a longer scarf, add extra repeats of the Foxmoor Lace pattern. You will need approximately 1 ball of yarn for every 24" added to the length.

#### NEEDLES AND OTHER MATERIALS:

Knitting needles in size US 3 (3.25mm)  
**or size to obtain gauge.**

Tapestry needle

**GAUGE:** 24 sts and 30 rows = 4" in Stockinette Stitch. **Take time to save time, check your gauge.**
