

Classic Elite Yarns

Fresco Holiday Napkin Rings

SIZE: One size

Finished Measurements: 6" circumference by 1" tall without embellishments

MATERIALS:

Fresco by **Classic Elite** (60% wool, 30% baby alpaca, 10% angora; 50 gram hank = approx 164 yards)

- 1 hank Color A—5301 Parchment
- 1 hank Color B—5385 Tandori Spice
- 1 hank Color C—5312 Superman Yellow
- 1 hank Color D—5350 Ginger
- 1 hank Color E—5378 Alpaca Brown
- 1 hank Color F—5358 Tomato
- 1 hank Color G—5355 Rumba Red
- 1 hank Color H—5376 Moss
- 1 hank Color I—5335 Pea Pod
- 1 hank Color J—5381 Fair Green
- 1 hank Color K—5357 Delft Blue

Needles

- One pair size US 5 (3.75 mm)

Or size to obtain gauge

- Two double pointed needles (dnp) size US 5 (3.75 mm)

GAUGE: 24 sts and 48 rows = 4" in Garter St.

Take time to save time, check your gauge.

SPECIAL TERMS:

ssk: (slip, slip, knit) Slip 2 sts, 1 at a time, knitwise to the RH needle; return sts to LH needle in turned position and knit them together through the back loops (1 st decreased).

k2tog: Knit 2 sts together (1 st decreased).

k1-f/b: Knit into the front loop, then the back loop of next st (1 st increased).

sk2p: Slip 1 st knitwise, from the LH needle to the RH needle, k2tog, pass slipped st over knit st created by k2tog (2 sts decreased).

sp2p: Slip 1 st knitwise, from the LH needle to the RH needle, purl 2 sts together, pass slipped st over knit st created by p2tog (2 sts decreased).

PATTERN STITCHES:

Garter Stitch (Gtr St): Knit every row.

Seed Stitch: (multiple of 2 sts + 1)

Row 1: (RS) K1, *p1, k1; rep from * to end.

Row 2: Knit the purl sts and purl the knit sts as they face you.

Rep Row 2 for Seed St.

I-Cord: With sts on 1 dnp *use second dnp to knit 1 row; without turning the work, slide the sts to RH end of needle, pull yarn tightly from the end of row (behind the sts); rep from *until cord meas desired length.



Shown from left to right: Seed Ring I with Basic Leaf C; Garter Ring H with Aspen leaves B and D; Garter Ring B with Basic leaf F; Stripe Ring; Garter Ring E with Maple Leaf G; Garter Ring D with Maple Leaf C.

Cable Cast-on Method: *Insert RH needle between first 2 sts on LH needle, k1 from this position, leave the first st on LH needle and slip new st onto LH needle. Rep from * for desired number of sts.

French Knot: See illustration on page 2.

GARTER RING

(Make two in Color A, and one in each: Color B, Color D, and Color E) With color of choice, CO 37 sts. **(RS) Begin Gtr St;** work for 11 rows, end after a RS row. (WS) BO all sts knitwise.

SEED RING

With Color I, CO 37 sts. **(RS) Begin Seed St;** work for 11 rows, end after a RS row. BO all sts knitwise.

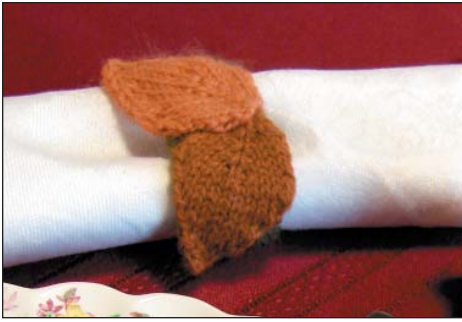


STRIPED RING

With Color E, CO 37 sts. **(RS) Begin Gtr St;** work 2 rows, end after a WS row. **Change to Color F:** (RS) work 2 rows, end after a WS row. **Change to Color B:** (RS) work 2 rows, end after a WS row. **Change to Color F:** (RS) work 2 rows, end after a WS row. **Change to Color A:** (RS) work 3 rows, end after a RS row. (WS) BO all sts knitwise.

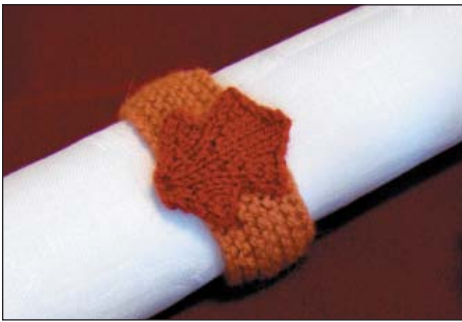

ASPEN LEAF

Make 2—one in Color B and one in Color D.
With color of choice, CO 5 sts.
Row 1: (RS) K1, [k1-f/b] 2 times, k2—7 sts.
Row 2 and all WS rows: Purl.
Row 3: K2, [k1-f/b] 2 times, k3—9 sts.
Row 5: K3, [k1-f/b] 2 times, k4—11 sts.
Row 7: K4, [k1-f/b] 2 times, k5—13 sts.
Row 9: Ssk, k9, k2tog—11 sts.
Row 11: Ssk, k5, k2tog—9 sts.
Row 13: Ssk, k5, k2tog—7 sts.
Row 15: Ssk, k3, k2tog—5 sts.
Row 17: Ssk, k1, k2tog—3 sts.
Row 19: Sk2p—1 st.
Thread yarn through rem st to fasten off.



BASIC LEAF

Make 2—one in Color C and one in Color F.
With color of choice, CO 5 sts.
Row 1: (RS) K1, [k1-f/b] 2 times, k2—7 sts.
Row 2, 4 and 6: Purl.
Row 3: K1, k1-f/b, k2, k1-f/b, k2—9 sts.
Row 5: K1, k1-f/b, k4, k1-f/b, K2—11 sts.
Row 7: BO 3 sts [k1, k1-f/b] 2 times, k5—10 sts.
Row 8: BO 3 sts, p6—7 sts.
Row 9: K1, [k1-f/b, k2] 2 times—9 sts.
Rows 10 and 12: Purl.
Row 11: K1, k1-f/b, k4, k1-f/b, k2—11 sts.
Row 13: BO 3 sts, k7—8 sts.
Row 14: BO 3 sts, p4—5 sts.
Row 15: Sk2p—3 sts.
Row 16: Purl.
Row 17: Sk2p—1 st.
Thread yarn through rem st to fasten off.



MAPLE LEAF

Make 2—one in Color G and one in Color C.
With color of choice, CO 5 sts. **Begin I-Cord;**
work for 1".
Row 1: (RS) [K1-f/b] 4 times, k1—9 sts.
Rows 2, 4, and 6: Purl.
Row 3: [K1-f/b] 8 times, k1—17 sts.
Row 5: Knit.
Row 7: BO 3 sts, knit to end—14 sts.
Row 8: BO 3 sts, purl to end—11 sts.
Rows 9 and 11: Knit.
Rows 10 and 12: Purl.
Row 13: BO 3 sts, knit to end—8 sts.
Row 14: BO 3 sts, purl to end—5 sts.
Row 15: Sk2p—3 sts.
Row 16: Purl.
Row 17: Sk2p—1 st.
Thread yarn through rem st to fasten off.



HOLLY LEAF

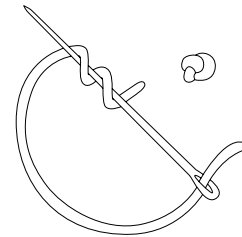
Make 2 in Color E.
With Color E, CO 5 sts.
Row 1: (RS) K1, [k1-f/b] 2 times, k2—7 sts.
Rows 2, 4 and 6: Purl.
Row 3: K2, [k1-f/b] 2 times, k3—9 sts.
Row 5: Knit.
Row 7: BO 1 st, k7—8 sts rem.
Row 8: BO 1 st, p6—7 sts rem.
Row 9: BO 1 st, k5—6 sts rem.
Row 10: BO 1 st, p4—5 sts rem.
Row 11: BO 1 st, k3—4 sts rem.
Row 12: BO 1 st, k2—3 sts rem.
Row 13: Sk2p—1 st rem.
Thread yarn through rem st to fasten off.



DREIDEL

With Color K, CO 3 sts.
Rows 1–4: Knit.
Row 5 (RS): K3, using Cable Cast-on Method,
CO 4 sts—7sts.
Row 6: P7, using Cable Cast-on Method, CO
4 sts—11 sts.
Rows 7, 9, 11, and 13: Knit.
Rows 8, 10, 12, and 14: Purl.
Row 15: Ssk, k7, k2tog—9 sts rem.
Rows 16, 18 and 20: Purl.
Row 17: Ssk, k5, k2tog—7 sts rem.
Row 19: Ssk, k3, k2tog—5 sts rem.
Row 21: Ssk, k1, k2tog—3 sts rem.
Row 22: Sp2p—1 st rem.
Thread yarn through rem st to fasten off.

FINISHING

Block all pcs. Sew the short ends of each ring
together (seams are at the center back of
ring). Sew leaves to corresponding rings as
shown in photo on page 1; add french knots
to the Holly Leaves as shown in the photo in
the center column.
