

Classic Elite Yarns

“INTERLUDE” LACE WRAP

SIZES: One Size

Finished Measurements: 14" wide x 60" long

MATERIALS:

Interlude by **Classic Elite** (30% silk, 70% linen, 50 gram hank = approx 82 yards)

- 5 hanks

Needles

- One pair size US 8 (5 mm)

Or size to obtain gauge

GAUGE: 15 sts and 20 rows = 4" in Lace Patt.

Take time to save time, check your gauge.

SPECIAL TERMS:

yo: Yarn over (1 st increased).

ssk: (slip, slip, knit) Slip 2 sts, 1 at a time, knitwise to the RH needle; return sts to LH needle in turned position and knit them together through the back loops (1 st decreased).

k2tog: Knit 2 sts together (1 st decreased).

PATTERN STITCHES:

Garter Stitch (Gtr st): Knit every row.

Stockinette Stitch (St st): Knit on RS, purl on WS.

Lace Pattern: (multiple of 10 sts + 4)

(also, see chart)

Row 1 (RS): K4, *yo, ssk, k1, [k2tog, yo] 2 times, k3; rep from * across.

Row 2 and all WS rows: Purl.

Row 3: *K3, [yo, ssk] 2 times, k1, k2tog, yo; rep from *, end k4.

Row 5: K2, *[yo, ssk] 3 times, k4; rep from *, end yo, ssk.

Row 7: K1, *[yo, ssk] 4 times, k2; rep from *, end yo, ssk, k1.

Rows 9: Rep Row 5.

Rows 11: Rep Row 3.

Rows 13: Rep Row 1.

Row 15: K2tog, yo, *k4, [k2tog, yo] 3 times; rep from *, end k2.

Row 17: K1, k2tog, yo, *k2, [k2tog, yo] 4 times; rep from *, end k1.

Row 19: Rep Row 15.

Row 20: Purl.

Rep Rows 1–20 for Lace Patt.

WRAP

CO 46 sts. **(WS) Begin Gtr st:** Work 3 rows even, end WS row. **Est Lace Patt:** (RS) K1 (edge st, keep in St st throughout) work across center 44 sts in Lace Patt, k1 (edge st, keep in St st throughout). Work even until piece



meas approx 59" from beg, end RS Row 19. **Change to Gtr st:** (WS) Work 3 rows even. (RS) BO all sts loosely.

FINISHING:

Block piece to measurements. This piece looks best if blocked tightly.
