# Classic Elite Yarns

### The Yarns

**Soft Linen** – 35% Linen, 35% Wool, 30% Baby Alpaca

Soft Linen is the perfect yarn for warmer days and soft, cool nights. The alpaca makes a beautiful halo, the linen gives it a crisp and firm hand and the wool provides stability and its own level of softness.

**Firefly** – 25% Linen, 75% Viscose

Firefly is a warm-weather yarn with a subtle sheen and wonderful hand. The juxtaposition of the linen with a light-catching sheen gives it a distinctly feminine look. Firefly drapes wonderfully at a wide range of gauges.

### The Pattern

**Skill Level:** Easy

**Finished Measurements**

47" circumference x 8" high

### YARN

**Soft Linen** by **Classic Elite Yarns**

(35% linen, 35% wool, 30% baby alpaca ; 50 g = 137 yards)

1 ball each:

Color A 2205 Royal Purple

Color B 2238 Buffalo Brown

**Firefly** by **Classic Elite Yarns**

(75% viscose, 25% linen; 50 g = 155 yards)

1 ball each:

Color C 7755 Corsica

Color D 7795 Thistle

### NEEDLES

Circular needle (24 or 32") in size US 6 (4 mm) **or size to obtain gauge.**

### OTHER MATERIALS

Stitch marker

### GAUGE

19 sts and 32 rows = 4" in 1 x 1 Rib.

**Take time to save time, check your gauge.**





## PATTERN STITCHES

**1 x 1 Rib** (even number of sts)

All rnds: \*K1, p1, rep from \* around.

**3 x 1 Rib** (multiple of 4 sts)

All rnds 1: \*P3, k1tbl; rep from \* around.

## COWL

With Color A, CO 228 sts. Place marker for BOR and join to begin working in the rnd, being careful not to twist sts. Work in 3 x 1 Rib until pc meas approx 2" from the beg.

Change to Color C and knit 1 rnd. Work in 1 x 1 Rib until pc meas approx 4" from the beg.

Change to Color B and knit 1 rnd. Work in 3 x 1 Rib until pc meas approx 6" from the beg.

Change to Color D and knit 1 rnd. Work in 1 x 1 Rib work even until pc meas approx 8" from the beg. Loosely BO all sts in rib.

## FINISHING

Block to measurements.

## ABBREVIATIONS

**approx:** approximately

**BO:** bind off

**BOR:** beginning of round

**CO:** cast on

**k:** knit

**k1tbl:** knit one stitch through the back of the loop

**meas:** measure(s)

**p:** purl

**pc:** piece

**rep:** repeat

**rnd(s):** round(s)

**st(s):** stitch(es)
