

La Gran Ribbed Stole

The Yarn

La Gran

78.4% mohair, 17.3% wool, 4.3% nylon

Mohair, the fiber from Angora goats, is fine and lustrous and has many of the good qualities of wool. Knit on a large needle, it produces a lightweight and airy fabric.

The mohair in La Gran is twisted with a wool (for warmth) and nylon (for strength) as a binder that keeps the mohair from shedding. The yarn is then brushed to bring out the lofty soft halo of the mohair fiber.

The Pattern

SIZE: One Size

Finished Meas: 17" wide x 80" long
(with ribbing blocked flat)

MATERIALS:

La Gran by **Classic Elite** (78.4% mohair, 17.3% wool, 4.3% nylon; 50g ball = approx 108 yards)

- 4 balls 61520 Blue Topaz

Needles

- One pair size US 15 (10 mm).

Or size to obtain gauge.

GAUGE: 9 sts and 12 rows = 4" in
2 x 2 Rib blocked flat. **Take time to save time, check your gauge.**

ABBREVIATIONS

BO: bind off

CO: cast on

k: knit

meas: measure(s)

p: purl

RS: right side

sts: stitch(es)

WS: wrong side



PATTERN STITCH

2 x 2 Rib (multiple of 4 sts + 2)

Row 1: (RS) *K2, p2; rep from * to last 2 sts, p2.

Row 2: *P2, k2; rep from * to last 2 sts, p2.

Repeat Row 2 for 2 x 2 Rib.

STOLE

CO 38 sts. **Begin 2 x 2 Rib** and work even until piece meas 80" from CO edge, end after a WS row. BO all sts loosely in pattern.

Finishing

Block piece to required measurements.
