## Lush Autumn Pullover

**Lush**  
50% angora, 50% wool

Lush is a blend of wool and angora spun into a 4 ply worsted-weight yarn. The wool in the mix keeps the yarn stable and sturdy, while the angora makes the yarn extremely soft and gives it a soft, cuddly feeling. Knitting with Lush is a pleasure—it has the hand of a luxury yarn but without the price. Lush comes in 24 colors that range from soft and subtle to rich and bold.

**SIZES:** Extra Small (Small, Medium, Large, Extra Large)

**Finished Measurements:**  
31 (34<sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub>, 37<sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub>, 41<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>, 45<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>)"

**MATERIALS:**

**Lush** by **Classic Elite** (50% angora 50% wool; 50 gram hank = approx 123 yards)

- 6 (7, 7, 8, 9) hanks 4468 Madder

**Needles:**

- One pair size US 8 (5 mm)

**Or size to obtain gauge.**

- Stitch markers

**GAUGE:** 17 sts and 24 rows= 4" in Stockinette Stitch. **Take time to save time, check your gauge.**

**SPECIAL TERMS:**

**ssk: (slip, slip, knit)** Slip 2 sts, 1 at a time, knit-wise to the RH needle; return sts to LH needle in turned position and knit them together through the back loops (1 st decreased).

**k2tog:** Knit 2 sts together (1 st decreased).

**m1: (make 1)** Insert LH needle under horizontal strand between st just worked and next st, from the front to the back, knit through the back loop (1 st increased).

**PATTERN STITCHES:**

**Stockinette Stitch (St st):** Knit on RS, purl on WS.

**Seed Stitch: (multiple of 2 sts)**

Row 1: (RS) \*K1, p1; rep from \* to end.

Row 2: Knit the purl sts and purl the knit sts as they face you.

Rep Row 2 for Seed St.

**BACK**

CO 66 (74, 80, 88, 96) sts. **Est Seed St:** (RS) K1 (seam st, keep in St st throughout), work to last st in Seed St, k1 (seam st, keep in St st

throughout). (WS) Work for 5 more rows, end after a WS row. **Change to St st;** (RS) work even until pc meas 4" from beg, end after a WS row. **Shape Waist, Dec Row:** (RS) K2, ssk, work to last 4 sts, k2tog, k2—2 sts dec'd. Rep waist dec row every 12<sup>th</sup> row 2 more times—60 (68, 74, 82, 90) sts rem. Work even until pc meas 9½" from beg, end after a WS row. **Shape Waist, Inc Row:** (RS) K2, m1, work to last 2 sts, m1, k2—2 sts inc'd. Rep waist inc row every 10<sup>th</sup> row 2 more times—66 (74, 80, 88, 96) sts. Work even until pc meas 15½" from beg, end after a WS row. **Shape Armholes:** (RS) BO 4 (4, 5, 6, 7) sts at beg of next 2 rows—58 (66, 70, 76, 82) sts rem. **Dec Row:** (RS) K2, ssk, work to last 4 sts, k2tog, k2—56 (64, 68, 74, 80) sts rem. Rep armhole dec row EOR 1 (4, 4, 6, 7) more times—54 (56, 60, 62, 66) sts rem. Work even until armhole meas 4 (4½, 5, 5½, 6)" from beg of armhole shaping, end after a WS row. **Est Seed St:** (RS) K1 (seam st, keep in St st throughout), work to last st in Seed St, k1 (seam st, keep in St st throughout).

Work as est until armhole meas 5 (5½, 6, 6½, 7)" from beg of armhole shaping end after a WS row. Place markers (pm) each side of center 30 (30, 32, 32, 34) sts. **Shape Neck:** (RS) Work to first marker as est, join second ball of yarn, BO center sts and work to end as est—12 (13, 14, 15, 16) sts rem each side. Working both sides at same time, work until armhole meas 7 (7½, 8, 8½, 9)" from beg of armhole shaping, end after a WS row. **Shape Shoulders:** (RS) At each armhole edge, BO 4 sts 3 (2, 1, 0, 0) times, then 5 sts 0 (1, 2, 3, 2) times, then 6 sts 0 (0, 0, 0, 1) time.

**FRONT**  
Work as for back.

**SLEEVE (make 2)**  
CO 46 (48, 54, 58, 62) sts. **Est Seed St:** (RS) K1 (seam st, keep in St st throughout), work to last st in Seed St, k1 (seam st, keep in St st throughout). Work as est until pc meas 3" from beg, end after a WS row. **Change to**

**St st;** work until pc meas 4" from beg, end WS row. **Shape Sleeve, Inc Row:** (RS) K2, m1, work to last 2 sts, m1, k2—2 sts inc'd. Rep sleeve inc row every 22<sup>nd</sup> row 1 more time—50 (52, 58, 62, 66) sts. Work until pc meas 9 (9, 9½, 9½, 10)" from beg, end after a WS row. **All Sizes: Shape Cap:** (RS) BO 4 (4, 5, 6, 7) at beg of next 2 rows—42 (44, 48, 50, 52) sts rem. **Dec Row:** (RS) K2, ssk, work to last 4 sts, k2tog, k2—2 sts dec'd. Rep cap dec row EOR 4 (7, 7, 8, 8) times, every 4<sup>th</sup> row 3 (3, 4, 4, 4) times, then EOR 7 (5, 5, 5, 6) times—12 (12, 14, 14, 14) sts rem. BO all sts.

**FINISHING**  
Block pcs to measurements. Sew shoulder seams. Set in sleeves; sew sleeve and side seams.
