

# Classic Elite Yarns

## Crochet Star Motif Scarf



**Designed by:** Kristen TenDyke

**SIZES:** One size

**Finished Measurements:** 7½" wide x 69½" long

**MATERIALS:**

**Princess** by **Classic Elite** (40% merino, 28% viscose, 10% cashmere, 7% angora 15% nylon; 50 gram ball = approx 150 yards)

- 1 ball 3420 Brahman Blue

**Crochet Hook**

- One size US G/6 (4 mm)

**Or size to obtain gauge**

- Tapestry needle

**GAUGE:** One motif = 3¾" from point to point (see Schematic on page 2).

**PATTERN STITCHES:**

**Chain (ch):** Begin by making a slip knot on your hook. Wrap the yarn around the hook (yarn over) and draw it through the loop on the hook to form the first chain. Rep this step as many times as instructed. (The loop on the hook is never included when counting the number of chains).

**Slip Stitch (sl st):** Insert hook in the indicated stitch, yarn over and draw through both the stitch and the loop on the hook.

**Double Crochet (dc):** Yarn over hook, insert hook into indicated stitch, yarn over and pull up a loop; (yarn over and draw through 2 loops on hook) 2 times.

**Single Crochet (sc):** Insert hook in indicated stitch, yarn over and pull up a loop; yarn over and draw through both loops on hook.

**NOTES:**

1. Joining points are shown on schematic as red dots. When working each motif, join to existing motifs at these points.
2. When joining to a point where 2 motifs are already joined, work joining sl st into previous joining sl st rather than into either ch-5 loop.

**FIRST STAR**

Ch 4, sl st into first ch to form ring.

**Rnd 1:** Ch 6 (counts as dc, ch-3), dc into ring, [ch 3, dc into ring] 4 times, ch 1, dc into third ch of beg ch-6.

**Rnd 2:** Sc into sp made by [ch-1 dc], \*ch 10, sl st into fifth ch from hook, ch 5, sc into next ch-3 sp; rep from \* around. Work final sc as a sl st into the beg sc of this rnd. Fasten off.

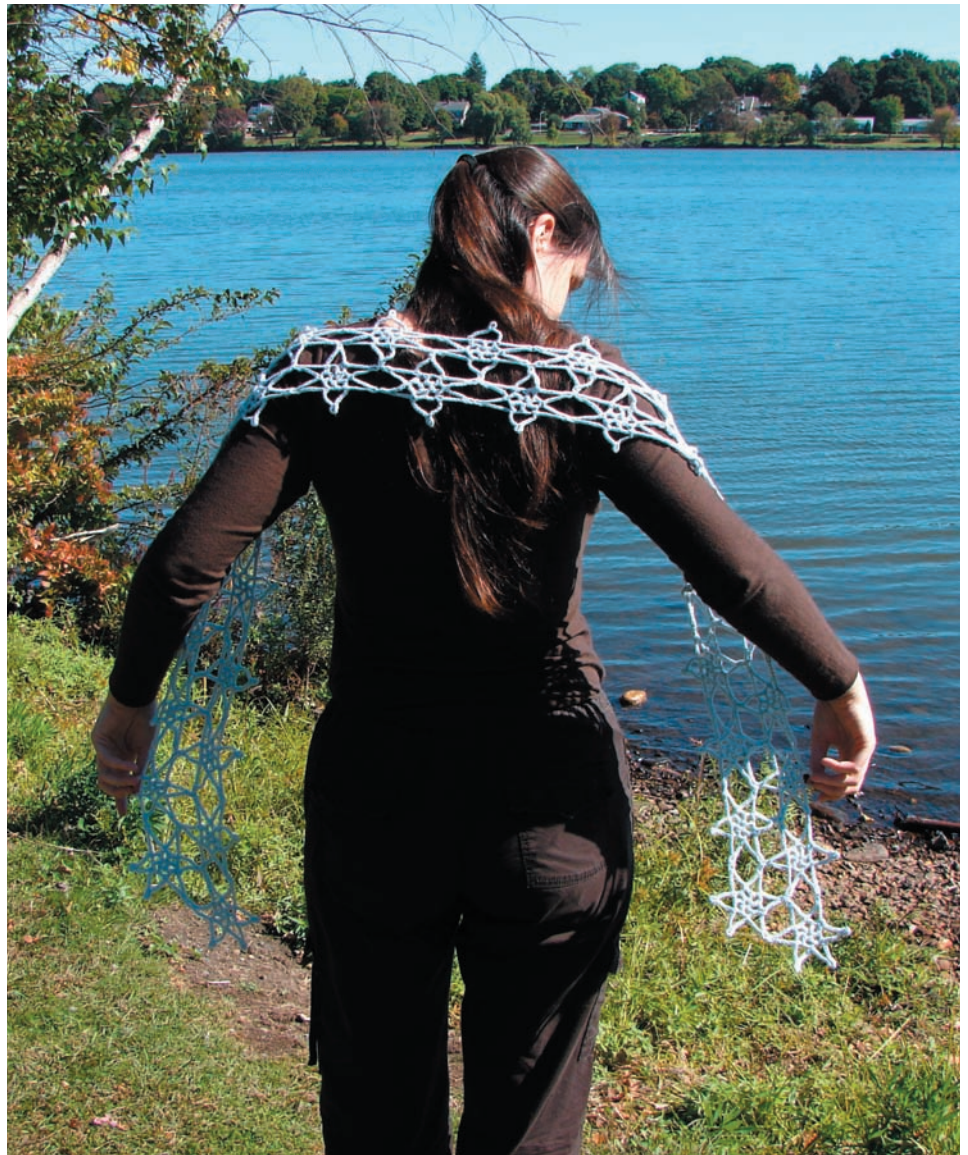
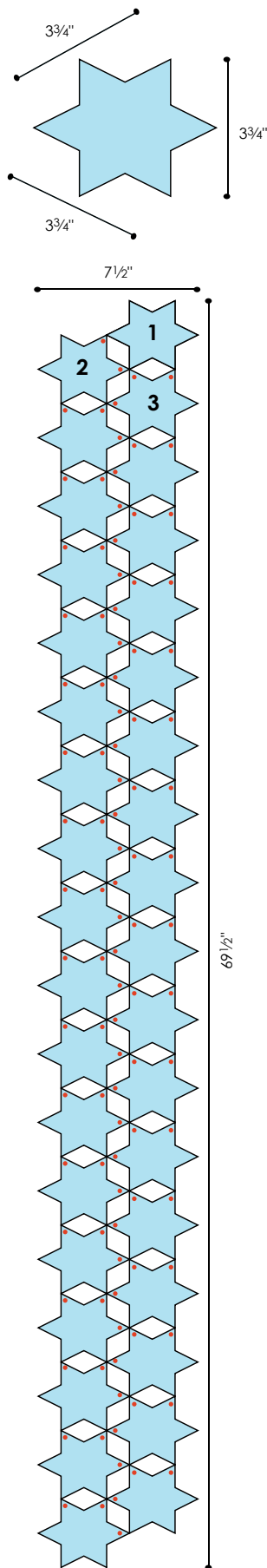


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### SECOND STAR

**Rnd 1:** Work as for First Star.

**Rnd 2:** Sc into sp made by [ch-1, dc], \*ch 7, sl st into corresponding ch-5 loop on first motif to join, ch 2, sl st into fifth ch from hook (counting sl st as a ch), ch 5, sc into next ch-3 sp; rep from \* 1 time; \*\*ch 10, sl st into fifth ch from hook, ch 5, sc into next ch-3 sp; rep from \*\* around, work final sc as a sl st into the beg sc of this rnd. Fasten off.

### THIRD STAR

**Rnd 1:** Work as for First Star.

**Rnd 2:** Sc into sp made by [ch-1, dc], \*ch 7, sl st into corresponding ch-5 loop on existing motif to join, ch 2, sl st into fifth ch from hook (counting sl st as a ch), ch 5, sc into next ch-3 sp; rep from \* 2 times; \*\*ch 10, sl st into fifth ch from hook, ch 5, sc into next ch-3 sp; rep from \*\* around, work final sc as a sl st into the beg sc of this rnd. Fasten off.

Rep Third Star for all rem star motifs joining to existing motifs as shown on schematic.

### FINISHING

Weave in ends.

- approx** – approximately
- beg** – begin(ning)
- ch** – chain (see Pattern Stitches)
- dc** – double crochet
- rep** – repeat
- rem** – remain(ning)
- rnd** – round
- sc** – single crochet
- sp** – space
- sl st** – slip stitch (see Pattern Stitches)
