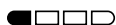


Classic Elite Yarns

Sundance Stethoscope Warmer

SIZES: One Size

Finished Measurements:

3½" around x 10½" long

MATERIALS:

Sundance by **Classic Elite** (50% cotton, 50% microfiber; 50 gram ball = approx 83 yards)

- 1 ball Main Color (MC) — 6290 Clear Water
- 1 ball Contrast Color (CC) — 6250 Straw Hat

Needles

- Four double pointed needles (dpn) size US 8 (5 mm)

Or size to obtain gauge

- Stitch marker

GAUGE: 22 sts and 20 rows = 4" in 1 x 1 Rib relaxed. **Take time to save time, check your gauge.**

PATTERN STITCHES:

Circular Stockinette Stitch (Stst): Knit every rnd.

Circular 1 x 1 Rib: (multiple of 2 sts)

Rnd 1: *K1, p1; rep from * around.

Rep Rnd 1 for 1 x 1 Rib.

WARMER

With MC, CO 18 sts, divide evenly onto 3 dpn. Join to beg working in-the-rnd, place marker for beg-of-rnd. **Begin St st;** work 1 rnd even. **Change to 1 x 1 Rib;** work for 6 rnds. ***Change to CC and St st;** work 1 rnd. **Change to 1 x 1 Rib;** work 2 rnds. **Change to MC and St st;** work 1 rnd. **Change to 1 x 1 Rib;** work 5 rnds. Rep from * 2 times. Cont with MC and 1 x 1 Rib until pc meas 10¼" or desired length from beg. **Change to St st;** work 2 rnds. BO all sts loosely knitwise.

FINISHING

Block pc to measurements if desired.



ABBREVIATIONS

approx – approximately

beg – begin(ning)

BO – bind off

CC – Contrast Color

CO – cast on

dpn – double pointed needles

k – knit

MC – Main Color

meas – measures

p – purl

pc – piece

rep – repeat

rnd(s) – round(s)

st(s) – stitch(es)

St st – Stockinette Stitch
