

Classic Elite Yarns

Summer Set Ribs and Cables Baby Cap

SIZES: Child's 0–6, (6–18, 18–48) months
Finished Measurements: 15, (17½, 19¾)" circumference

MATERIALS:

Summer Set by **Classic Elite** (64% cotton, 19% alpaca, 12% polyester, 5% lyocel; 50 gram ball = approx 95 yards)

- 1 (1, 2) balls 2147 Riptide

Needles

- One pair size US 6 (4 mm)

Or size to obtain gauge

- Two double pointed needles (dnp) size US 6 (4 mm) for I-cord
- Cable needle (cn)

GAUGE: 23 sts and 30 rows = 4" in Cable Rib Pattern, slightly stretched. **Take time to save time, check your gauge.**

SPECIAL TERMS:

C4F: Slip 2 sts to cn, hold in front; k2; k2 from cn.
ssk: (slip, slip, knit) Slip 2 sts, 1 at a time, knitwise to the RH needle; return sts to LH needle in turned position and knit them together through the back loops (1 st decreased).
p2tog: Purl 2 sts together (1 st decreased).
k2tog: Knit 2 sts together (1 st decreased).

PATTERN STITCHES:

Cable Rib Pattern: (multiple of 14 sts + 2)

(also, see chart)

Rows 1 and 3: (WS) K2, *p2, k2, p4, k2, p2, k2; rep from * to end.

Row 2: (RS) P2, *k2, p2, k4, p2, k2, p2; rep from * to end.

Row 4: P2, *k2, p2, C4F, p2, k2, p2; rep from * to end.

Rep Rows 1–4 for Cable Rib Patt.

I-Cord:

Using 2 dnp, CO 3 sts onto 1 needle. *Knit 1 row; without turning the work, slide the sts to RH end of needle, pull yarn tightly from the end of the row, (behind the sts); rep from * until cord meas desired length. Break yarn, pull tail through all 3 sts.

HAT

CO 86, (100, 114) sts. (WS) **Begin Cable Rib Patt;** work even until pc meas approx 5 (6, 7)" from beg, end WS Row 1 of Cable Rib Patt. **Shape Crown:** (RS) P2, *k1, ssk, p1, k4, p2tog, k1, ssk, p1; rep from * to end—68 (79, 90) sts rem. (WS) Work 1 row even, knit the



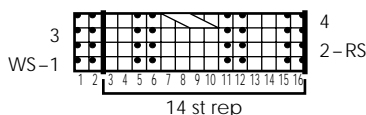
knit sts and purl the purl sts as they face you. (RS) P2, *ssk, p1, C4F, p1, ssk, p1; rep from * to end—56 (65, 74) sts rem. (WS) Work 1 row even. (RS) P1, *[k2tog] 2 times, k2, ssk, k1; rep from * to last st, p1—37 (43, 49) sts rem. (WS) Work 1 row even. (RS) K2tog, C4F, *ssk, C4F; rep from * to last 2 sts, ssk—31 (36, 41) sts rem. (WS) Work 1 row even. (RS) K1 (0, 1), *ssk; rep from * to end—16 (18, 21) sts rem. Break yarn. Thread tail through all sts and pull tight.

FINISHING

Sew seam. Using dnp CO 3 sts. Work I-cord for 15". Attach to top of hat in the center of cord. Tie a bow

Cable Rib Chart

(multiple of 14 sts + 2; 4 row rep)



- Knit on RS, purl on WS
- Purl on RS, knit on WS
- Slip 2 sts to cn, hold in front; k2; k2 from cn
