Allegoro
70% organic cotton, 30% linen

Allegoro is a blend of 70% organically grown cotton and 30% linen: enough linen to give a summery linen crispness and cotton to add softness and keep the yarn from getting too wiry (as pure linen is prone to do).

In keeping with its earth-friendly fiber content, Allegoro is dyed using GOTS certified non-toxic dyes. (You can find out more about GOTS standards here: www.global-standard.org.) These dyes yield beautiful soft colors and Allegoro comes in 13 enticing shades.

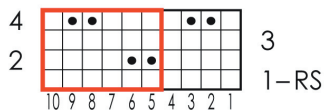
SIZES: One size
Finished Measurements:
18" wide and 13½" long.

MATERIALS:
Allegoro by Classic Elite (70% organic cotton, 30% linen; 50 gram ball = approx 152 yards)
• 2 balls 5685 Orange Zest
Needles:
• One pair size US 5 (3.75 mm)
Or size to obtain gauge.
• Tapestry needle
• Stitch marker
• One 1" toggle button

GAUGE: 21 sts and 32 rows = 4" in Double Fleck Pattern. **Take time to save time, check your gauge.**

SPECIAL TERMS:
k2tog: Knit 2 sts together (1 st decreased).
yo: Yarn over (1 st increased).
ssk: (slip, slip, knit) Slip 2 sts, 1 at a time, knitwise to the RH needle; return sts to LH needle in turned position and knit them together through the back loops (1 st decreased).

Double Fleck Chart
(multiple of 6 sts + 4; 4 row rep)



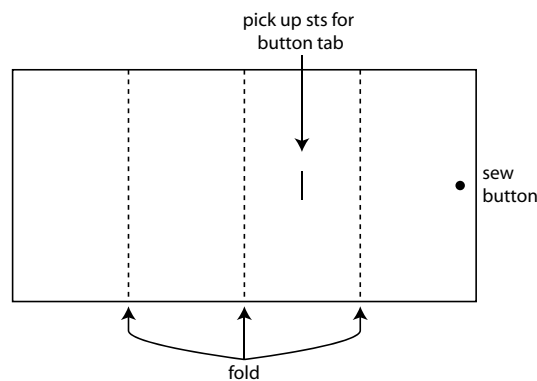
- knit on RS, purl on WS
- purl on RS, knit on WS
- pattern repeat

PATTERN STITCHES:
Double Fleck Pattern: (multiple of 6 sts + 4)
(also, see chart)
Rows 1, 3 (RS): Knit.
Row 2: P4, *k2, p4; rep from * to end.
Row 4: P1, k2, *p4, k2; rep from * to last st, p1.
Rep rows 1–4 for Dbl Fleck Patt.

Garler Stitch (Gtr St): Knit all sts, every row.
Stockinette Stitch (St st): Knit on RS, purl on WS.

NAPKIN
CO 94 sts. **(WS) Begin Gtr St;** work 3 rows, ending after a WS row. **Est Patt:** (RS) Work 3 sts in Gtr St, place marker (pm), work 88 sts in Dbl Fleck Patt, pm, work 3 sts in Gtr St. Cont as est until pc meas approx 13" from beg, end after row 4 of Dbl Fleck Patt. **Change to Gtr St;** work 4 rows, ending after a WS row. (RS) BO all sts knitwise.

FINISHING
Button Tab: Fold napkin in half width wise, then fold it in half again. Fold it in half lengthwise to find the center. Pick-up and knit 4 sts on either side of center, as shown in diagram—8 sts total. **Begin Gtr St;** work 27 rows. **Buttonhole Row:** K2, k2tog, [yo] twice, ssk, k2. Knit next row, dropping the extra yo—7 sts rem. Work 3 more rows. **Dec Row 1:** Ssk, k3, k2tog—5 sts rem. Work 1 row. **Dec Row 2:** Ssk, k1, k2tog—3 sts rem. Work 1 row. Sk2p—1 st rem. Fasten off. Sew button opposite buttonhole. Block pc to measurements.
